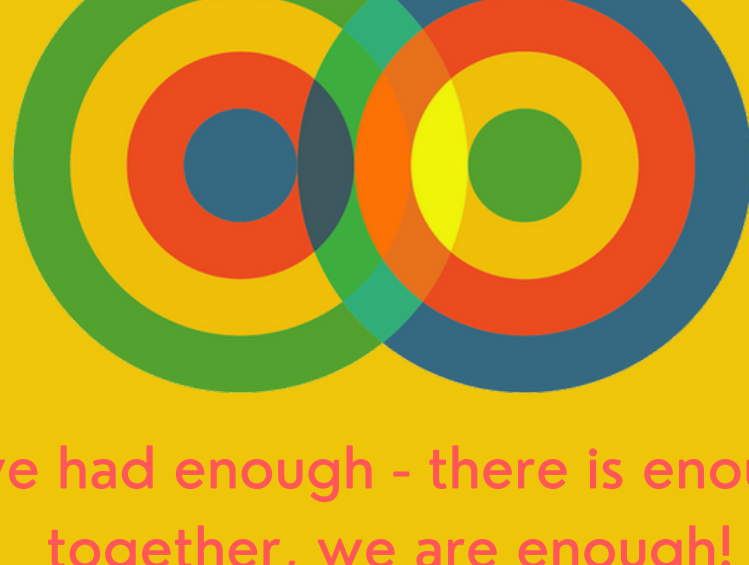

DEGROWTH



We believe that growing our economy is costing us our future. This story of growth is so embedded in our ways of living that any kind of change demands the complete re-imagination of our society. We believe that not only is this possible, it is now essential.

DECOLONISATION

Regaining the freedoms and possibilities lost through the imposition of oppressive ideologies, systems and practices. A process of remembering, re-imagining and reclaiming. The re-opening of a world and the healing of ruptures caused by violent separation.



PANDEMIC RESPONSE

The need to respond sensitively to a global pandemic and the pain and instability it has brought to people's lives has necessitated a shift of our work towards advocating explicitly for an economy that centres care and mutuality. We seek to challenge perceptions that degrowth is primarily about downscaling.

EMERGING CONTEXT

Pandemic crisis interventions make a mockery of political inaction on climate breakdown. Lockdown ennui meets marginalisation and predictable Brexit realpolitik. Hauntology meets hyperreal soft authoritarianism. One gigantic stuck container ship lays bare the perverse fragility of global supply chains. A Scottish election cycle in which little of substance appears to be proposed in response to the metacrisis that threatens the basis of life.

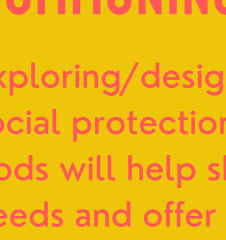

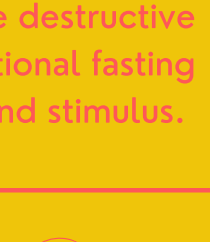
DEGROWTH NETWORK

LESS FOR LENT

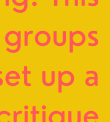

DEGROWTH IN SCOTLAND SHORT FILM

Working with the Media Co-op to script and shoot a short film on degrowth in Scotland that can be shared online to promote and help contextualise Enough's work.

AD FREE GLASGOW



The creation of an Adfree Glasgow group to articulate a positive vision for our cities, free from corporate outdoor advertising. This group will begin will work together to host discussion groups talking about positive alternatives for ad spaces such, set up a system for fighting new planning applications and develop a critique of outdoor advertising.
